RE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A LAND EVALUATION SITE ASSESSMENT SYSTEM (LESA)

WHEREAS, the County of Kankakee is predominantly agricultural and has a wide variety of soil types and land uses; and,

WHEREAS, in recent years, the agricultural sector has been interspersed with rural residential uses other than those connected to agriculture; and,

WHEREAS, under the Illinois Farmland Preservation Act of 1982, as amended, the State of Illinois mandates the preservation of agriculture farm land; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Kankakee has reviewed a Land Evaluation and Site Assessment System (LESA), attached hereto as Exhibit A, to determine the quality of land for agricultural uses and to assess sites or land areas for their highest and best use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Land Evaluation and Site Assessment System (LESA), attached hereto as Exhibit A, be adopted.
