Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?	Yes. Certain <u>preventive care</u> services and services with a <u>copayment and prescription drugs</u> are covered before you meet your deductible.	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.

Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? Yes.

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.
